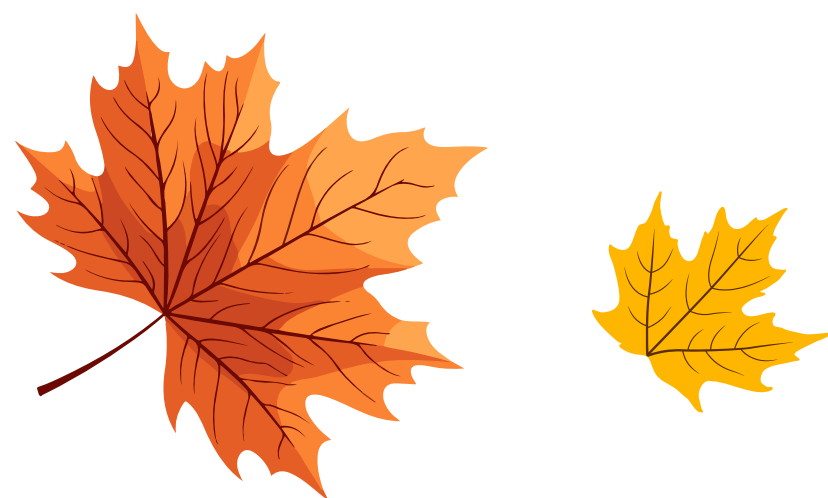
“So do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring worries of its own. Today’s trouble is enough for today.”
